Aluminum twin-piston front calipers reduce unsprung weight and enhance brake pedal feel.

It's fairly simple. Your life amounts to the choices you make. A car might not define you, but it comes pretty close.

There are four Mustang models to choose from. The coupe comes with the split port V6 and a whole lot of gawkers. The convertible V6 may also attract its share of attention. But, then again, it could be your tan.

The Mustang GT is simply the performer. The modular 4.6-liter V8 accounts for the second exhaust tip out the back. Along with its 260-horsepower air of suggestion. And think of the GT convertible as the Mustang that couldn't decide between eight cylinders and sunshine. So, it took both.



The 3.8-liter V8 splits even more torque than the V6. 190 horsepower at 5,250 rpm, and produces 302 ft. lbs. of torque at 2,750 rpm. You can see that torque and horsepower are relatively "fat." This means smooth, consistent acceleration throughout the rpm range.



The new-shiny modular 4.6-liter single-overhead cam V8 delivers 260 horsepower at 5,000 rpm and 302 ft. lbs. of torque at 4,000 rpm. It's the kind of engine that likes to perform at higher rpm. Note all the torque you get at the higher end.

And the smooth 3.8-liter V6, which gets its power from split-port induction, easy-flow cylinder heads, and low-friction piston coatings.


